Guidelines for Starting a Club



Starting a club affiliated with Horse Archery USA is easier than you think. Here's a list of what you'll need to get started:

- A Club Name
- A logo image for our website
- A Contact Person or Club Leader
- At least three founding members who are all members of HAUSA in good standing
- Bylaws or a Club Charter that outline your club's operations and purpose
 - Horse Archery USA will gladly provide you with a sample Charter from an existing club if you would like to see what's included. We can also help guide you through the process of creating your own group's bylaws.
- A practice location that is at least 50 miles away from any other existing HAUSA affiliated club. Current clubs may offer up to two different practice locations to accommodate their members. Clubs may form within the allotted distance only with the express permission of the existing club, approval of the HAUSA Board of Directors, AND with the intent to work cooperatively with the current affiliate club.
- It is helpful to have a social media page and/or website for your group. Once the affiliation process has been completed and approved by the HAUSA Board of Directors, you must list us as your affiliate organization and feature our logo on your site and social pages.
- A \$200 affiliation fee to be paid once your approval process has been completed. HAUSA has the right to place any club, new or current, under a probationary period to monitor activity and leadership of that group.
